JOB TITLE: ON - SITE CAMP DIRECTOR

PAY RATE: APPROXIMATELY \$428.00 PER WEEK

HOURS PER WEEK: APPROXIMATELY 40

JOB DUTIES: Under the supervision of the Executive Camp Directors, this person will be responsible for the supervision of camp personnel and program. Assists in the development and implementation of daily camp activities, supervises camp participants, and interacts with parents as needed. This person is the Primary Care Provider, administering first aid and medication as needed. Provides a fun, safe and positive environment for camper. Implement weekly staff meetings and program staff training. Participates in overnight and late night activities. Must be available Monday through Friday. June 25th through August 17th. In addition, must be available for training dates TBA prior to June 25th.
